- and proclaimed himself King of Hebron (15:7-12)

David flees (15:13-18)

Ittai the Gittite (15:19-23 then 18:2)	Ziba the steward of Mephibosheth (16:1-4 c.f. 9:1-13 then 19:24-30)
Zadok and Abiathar the priests (15:24-29)	Shimei son of Gera (16:5-16)
Hushai the Arkite (15:32-37)	Ahithophel (15:30-31, 16:15-17:23)

Taking on the Lord

- 'Lord, turn Ahithophel's counsel into foolishness' (15:31)
- 'the advice Ahithophel gave was like that of one who inquires of God.' (16:23)
- 'the Lord had determined to frustrate the good advice of Ahithophel in order to bring disaster on Absalom' (17:14)

Absalom (using God's people to become King) vs. David (the King of God's people)

(17:24-18:8)

Absalom dies (18:9-18)
